CHILI LIME TACOS produced by Morgan Ducret INGREDIENTS

- ☐ 1 lb. boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cut into bite-size pieces
- ☐ 2 Tbsp. olive oil, divided
- □ 1 1/2 tsp. chili powder
- ☐ 1 clove garlic, finely chopped
- ☐ 2 Tbsp. fresh lime juice
- ☐ 1 medium poblano pepper, chopped (about 2/3 cup)
- ☐ 1 small red onion, chopped (about 1 cup)
- ☐ 1 package Knorr® Rice Sides™ Rice Pilaf
- 8 corn tortillas or taco shells

DIRECTIONS

- Combine 1 tablespoon olive oil with chili powder; add chicken and toss to coat.
- Cook chicken in a large skillet on medium heat, stirring frequently, for about 6 minutes. Add garlic to skillet and cook, stirring, for about 30 seconds. Add lime juice; toss. Remove from heat and set aside.
- 3. Heat remaining tablespoon of chili oil in same skillet on medium-high heat, and cook poblano pepper and onion, stirring occasionally until softened, about 4 minutes. Add 2 cups water to skillet and Knorr® Rice Sides™ - Rice Pilaf and cook according to package directions. Stir in chicken.
