CA Baseball, Softball Playoffs: Lady Mohawks Advance To Semifinals

Both of the Colebrook Academy Varsity Baseball and Softball teams have advanced to the playoffs.

The baseball team seeded 10th in Division 4 and traveled to Hopkinton High School (seeded 8th) on May 31. The boys held the team very close, 5-4 until the third inning, then lost 19-4.

The Varsity Softball team was seeded 5th in Division 4, and played 12th-seeded Lin-Wood Lumberjacks on May 30 here in Colebrook. The teams were tied until the 6th inning, when CA pulled a win through the 12-run rule.

The quarterfinals saw the Lady Mohawks playing on the road against fourth-seed the Wilton Warriors on June 2. The Mohawks were held 2-2 in the third, and fell behind 5-2 in the fourth. It wasn't until the final inning when Colebrook scored again, winning 6-5.

The girls will play in the semifinal round against Epping (seeded 1st) on Wednesday June 6 at 7pm at Plymouth State University.

Netflix Series Strikes A Nerve

On Friday, May 18, the Netflix Original Series "13 Reasons Why" was renewed for a second season. The show's first season, which arrived on Netflix on March 31 of last year, followed the plot line of the novel "Thirteen Reasons Why" by Jay Asher. The show visualizes the aftermath of a girl's suicide when she leaves thirteen tape recordings to the people she felt caused her distress and ultimately her death. Previous fans were very excited to see what the second season had in store for the show's characters.

The show's producers do not try to soften the subject matter of the show, which has graphic scenes of substance abuse, violence, suicide, and both male and female forms of sexual assault. Although some have expressed concerns about its graphic nature, many have described "13 Reasons Why" as an accurate depiction of the issues dealt with by teens today.

The show warns viewers of graphic scenes and content before most episodes and provides resources for hotline centers at the end of every episode.

Many teens go through similar situations that are presented through the show. Parents, teachers and adults often question why many kids do not seek help, and the characters explain the difficulty of discussing their personal issues.
