National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day

On this day in 1941, at 7:55 a.m., the United States Naval Base at Pearl Harbor was attacked by about 200 Japanese aircrafts. Just about all of the Pacific Fleet was held there, and only a few escaped damage. In all, 2,403 people were killed, and 1,178 were wounded. The surprise attack lasted about an hour, but had a much larger effect on the country: on December 8, 1941, the U.S. formally declared war

On August 23, 1994 the Congress designated December 7 to be National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day. The American flag is to be flown at half-staff and veterans who were serving at the time shall be honored.
