During the 2018 - 19 school year, students ages 15-18 years old have the option of learning abroad through the American Scandinavian Student Exchange (ASSE) International Student Exchange Program. The ASSE have been helping students study abroad for over 30 years.

ASSE offers the largest number of countries to travel to, ranging from Canada to the Czech Republic to Hong Kong. Students are not required to know the native language of that country. ASSE also provides scholarships to those in need. While the program can last a full year, the participant gets to choose either a full year or just a semester.

Academy Debuts New Final Exam Schedule

There has been a recent change in the exam schedule. The first day of exams is Wednesday, January 17, when classes in Blocks 1 and 2 will take their exams during the regularly scheduled times. The rest of the day will follow the normal schedule of lunch/advisory and Blocks 3 and 4. Students who have a Period 7 class will be expected to take that exam during Block 4 on Wednesday.

On Thursday, January 18, exams for Block 3 and 4 classes will be given during the Block 1 and 2 times. Students with a Period 8 class will take their exam during the Block 4 time slot.

After exams have finished at 10:59 on Thursday, students will be dismissed, but must make arrangements for their own transportation, as buses will only run during the normally scheduled times. Any students with outstanding debts, as well as seniors who haven't completed their yearbook pages will not be offered early dismissal until their pages are complete.
